General

Increase or Decrease in Travel. Visitation for the month 6,002. This is an increase of 74.7% over April 1963.

Park roads from West Entrance to Old Faithful and Mammoth were opened to public travel on April 6. Roads were closed on the nights of April 11, 16 and 25, due to weather conditions.

Visitors. Mr. Bob Toulouse, Vacationland Studios, Sheridan, Wyomong visited the Park for a week. He took pictures at Old Faithful, Hayden Valley, Canyon and Cooke City way for a film for the Wyoming Travel Commission.

Special Activities. Superintendent McLaughlin was in the Director's office in Washington, D. C. from April 20 throughout the remainder of the month in connection with further work on the North Cascades Study. On the 27th and 28th he along with several other National Park Service representatives met with U. S. Forest Service personnel on matters pertaining to the Study.

Buildings and Utilities. Hathaway Construction Company has completed the interior painting of the Lamar Research Center building.

Health. Fifteen water samples were collected throughout the Park and analyzed in the Park laboratory. Three samples from Mammoth and one from Old Faithful showed evidence of contamination caused by low chlorine residuals in the water.

The air sampler was operated twice in cooperation with the National Air Sampling Network.

Roads. Spring snow removal was completed on Park roads scheduled for opening on May 1 except the Canyon-Tower section. Snow pack was slightly below normal on the East and South Entrance roads. Mt. Washburn road was plowed early to facilitate fueling of the radio system power plant. Snow on this section was deeper than usual.

Campgrounds. Mr. and Mrs. L. L. Long, Yucaipa, California, were the Park's first kampers. They arrived April 27 and camped at Old Faithful for a week. They have visited the Park for 17 seasons and were thrilled at the wildlife that was evident as the Park opened.

Elk Census Montans Fish and Game representatives took a census by helicopter of the Upper Gallatin elk herd on April 8. Park Management biologist Robert E. Howe participated in all flights over the Park, Count: 1,182.

Park Rangers cooperated with Montana S ateCollege in biological elk collections in the cooperative elk research program.

Moose A cow moose and yearling were observed along the Firehole River in the Old Faithful area on April 6; ten were observed along the Gallatin road, including two calves.

Birds Many song birds have been seen including Redwing Blackbirds, robins, Mountain Bluebird, and Oregon Juncos.

Trumpeter Swan and Canada geese have been observed on the Madison and Lamar rivers.


