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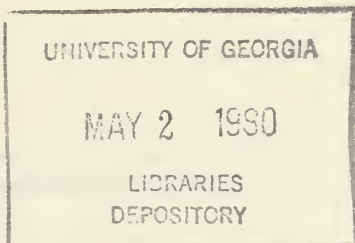

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Department of the Interior grants to private companies or individuals the privileges of providing facilities and services that are considered necessary for the accommodation and convenience of park visitors. This booklet lists alphabetically by areas the overnight lodging accommodations, and other facilities and services concessioners provide for travelers in the National Park System. Additional facilities are usually provided in nearby communities. Information on those facilities may be obtained from Chambers of Commerce, automobile associations, travel guides and travel agents.

The areas of the National Park System are open to visitors all year, climatic conditions permitting. Visitor facilities are also open all year unless otherwise noted (dates are subject to minor changes.)

The lodgings include hotels, motels, cabins, cottages, and trailer villages, providing trailer rentals in some areas, and utility hookups for visitors pulling their own travel and vacation trailers. The locations of the lodgings within the areas are indicated on the maps in the informational folders issued by the National Park Service. These folders may be obtained at the entrance stations or by writing to the Superintendent of the area concerned. A National Park Service camping facilities booklet is available from the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, D. C. 20240.

Reservations and other detailed information may be obtained by writing directly to the concessioners at the addresses shown in this booklet. Early reservations are recommended for all overnight lodging, especially during late May through the middle of October, and during weekends and holidays at other times during the year.

The National Parks are your heritage; enjoy them to the utmost, but please leave them unimpaired for the benefit and enjoyment of the millions to follow.
